BILLINGS TOP SHOT 2013

<u>All Challenges</u>: Winning team will receive 1 point. In case of a tie, the team with best time will be the winner of that challenge and receive that point.

- 1.) Shooters will be shooting at target with give 4 inch bulls' eye targets at 20 yards (60 feet). Shooters will get 5 rounds of 9mm (to be shot with a Smith & Wesson M&P 9). Each hit in the 4 inch bulls eye will be 1 point for a possible total of 5 points. Shooters will get 2 practice rounds to be shot at a 4 inch target.
- 2.) Shooters will be shooting at five Swedish fish hanging inside of a hula hoop at 10 yards (30 feet). Shooters will get 5 rounds of 9mm (to be shot with a Springfield 5.25). Each fish hit will be 1 point for a possible total of 5 points. Shooters will get 2 practice rounds to be shot at a target with the fish outlined on it.
- 3.) Sling shot.

- 4.) Shooters will be shooting at 2 cigarettes taped to a target placed at 20 feet. Shooters will get 4 rounds of 40 S&W (to be shot with a Smith & Wesson M&P 40). Shooters will need to shoot the cigarette completely in half (two pieces). Each ciagarette split will be worth 1 point for a total of 2 possible points. Shooters will get 2 practice rounds to be shot at cigarettes outlined on a target.
- 5.) Shooters will shoot strong hand only at 3 different sized targets 4 inch (worth1 point), 3 inch (worth 2 points), and 2 inch (worth 3 points), placed at 40 feet. Each shooter will get 5 rounds of 9mm (to be shot with a Smith & Wesson M&P). Shooters will get 2 practice rounds to be shot at target placed at 40 feet.
- 6.) Darts.
- 7.) Shooters will need to shoot the flame off of a candle placed at 10 yards (30 feet). Shooters will get 3 rounds of 40 S&W (to be shot with the Springfield 5.25). Shoot the candle and you get no points. Shoot the flame for one point. Shooters will get 2 practice rounds to shoot at a candle drawn on a target.
- 8.) Shooter will be shooting at 6 lollipops placed down range at 25 yards (75 feet) for a possible total of 6 points. Shooters will be shooting a Smith & Wesson AR15 with open sights while kneeling and using the bench for stability. Shooters will get 2 rounds to shoot at a zeroing target.

**In case of a tie between 2 teams, there will be a tie breaker challenge. (To be determined). The Shooting Commissioner is Wade Fredrickson. All decisions are final. **

The winning team will break into individual play and shoot one challenge to determine $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ placing.
