M. SHAUN DONOVAN, Deputy Missoula, being duly sworn, deposes and says that on or about the 27th day of October, 2012, at Missoula County, the above-named Defendant committed the offense of CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS DRUGS - NOT OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. §45-9-102(6), punishable by 5 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

On or about the late evening hours of October 27<sup>th</sup> or early morning hours of October 28, 2012 the above-named Defendant knowingly had in his possession MDMA, a Schedule I dangerous drug, as defined by Section 50-32-101, MCA.

duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

-----I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of-----  
TREVOR MCGOUGAN POOLE for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in  
the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true,  
believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as  
specified in the accompanying complaint.

On the night of October 27-28, 2012 officers of the Missoula Drug Task  
Force were working at the 2012 Disco Blood Bath rave party on Cartage Road in  
Missoula County when they observed a male later identified as Trevor M. Poole,

engaged in a "hand to hand transaction" involving the exchange of cash for a plastic baggie. Suspecting a drug transaction, officers approached Poole who admitted having two "molly" pills in his pocket. "Molly" is a street name for MDMA a Schedule I dangerous drug. He also admitted purchasing the pills that night from a male who offered to sell him the drug.
