RESISTING ARREST, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. §45-7-301, punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$500 fine;.

The facts constituting the offense(s) are:

JENNIFER CLARK, Deputy County Attorney of Missoula County, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of SHANE ROY DAVIS for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

Officer Vreeland responded to 1644 S. 4th Street West with Officer Serba for a male who was found inside the residence. The unknown male was lying on the couch inside the residence with his pants around his ankles. The female resident had grabbed her three year old daughter and ran outside the home and called 911.

Officer Serba spoke with Courtney Hodek. She was holding her three year old daughter, who was clearly upset. Courtney was still in her night clothes and standing to the south side of 4th Street in front of her house. Courtney explained she had sent her daughter into the living room to retrieve something. She had run back into her mother's bedroom and asked to be picked up. When Courtney walked into the living room she saw a male who she did not know laying on her couch. The male had pulled his pants down all the way to his ankles and had his penis in his right hand as if he had just finished masturbating. Courtney and her daughter were both afraid and left the residence running out the front door.

Officer Serba and Officer Vreeland went inside and observed the male on the couch. Officer Vreeland woke the male up. He got up from the couch and resisted Officer Serba and Officer Vreeland attempt to place him into handcuffs. His pants were down around his ankles and he fell against the south wall of the living room and attempted to push himself away from the wall. The male was identified by his social security card as Shane Davis. He said he was not sure where he was but that he had permission to sleep there. He did not know Courtney or the person to the west of her house.
