JENNIFER CLARK, Deputy County Attorney of Missoula County, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of JOSHUA A JORDAN for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On November 23, 2012, at approximately 11:30 a.m., Missoula City Police Officers were dispatched to the C'Mon Inn at 2775 Expo Parkway for a report of a disturbance. Detective Stacy Lear interviewed the complainant, Shawna Golie. Golie stated she had spent the night at the hotel with her friend Joshua Jordan, but that when she arrived Jordan had another female, identified as Cynthia

Evers, staying with him. Jordan and Evers had a disagreement during the night after which Jordan locked Evers out of the room

Evers requested a blanket and stayed outside the room for the remainder of the night, attempting to get them to let her back inside. She had retrieved a taser from Jordan's jacket that was in the car and she spark tested it outside the door to let him know that she had it.

In the morning, Jordan opened the door and without saying anything, punched Evers "at least twice" on the left side of her head. Evers stated that she fell to the ground and that she saw "stars." Officer Vreeland asked why she did not use the taser to defend herself, and she stated she was not confident that she would be able to use it effectively. Officer Vreeland observed a small, bluish bump on the left side of Evers' head, just above her left eye. She stated it felt like the side of her face was swollen.

Jordan has one conviction for partner/family member assault and a pending partner/family member assault case.
