FRED VAN VALKENBURG. County Attorney of Missoula County. Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of WARREN SOSS for allegedly committing the offense set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the abovenamed defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 13th day of November, 2012 Missoula County Detention Officer Warren Soss informed Detention Officer Michelle van Halen (a control room officer) that he was going to enter inmate Jade Gunhammer's cell in order to remove garbage from the cell. Detention Officer Andrew Gaylord advised that he would assist Soss.

At approximately 9:30 AM, Officers Soss and Gaylord entered Gunhammer's cell. Officer Soss began picking up garbage from the cell. At some point, Gunhammer attempted to leave the cell and Officer Gaylord prevented Gunhammer from leaving in his cell by placing his hand on Gunhammer's arm. Officer van Halen also observed Officer Soss assist Gunhammer in getting back into his cell. Officer van Halen reported that it appeared that Officer Soss physically moved Gunhammer by placing a hand on each of Gunhammer's arms and guiding him back into his cell. It appeared that Officer Gaylord assisted Officer Soss by holding onto one of Gunhammer's arms. Officer van Halen reported seeing a slight scuffle but that she could not tell what exactly was happening because her view was blocked by the officers' bodies. Officer van Halen reported that after Gunhammer stopped making attempts to exit his cell, the officers cleared the cell and returned to the control room at approximately 9:33 AM.

Subsequently, Deputy Sheriff Detective David Conway was assigned to investigate the incident. His investigation included obtaining a video recording made of Gunhammer's cell and the dayroom area immediately outside the cell during the approximate time of the incident. The video showed the following events:

Officers Gaylord and Soss entered Gunhammer's cell to retrieve garbage items. Gunhammer was agitated and did not want officers in the cell and tried to prevent Officer Soss from taking his garbage. While Officer Soss was picking up garbage, Gunhammer tried to push past Officer Gaylord and they struggled at the door. Officer Soss came up behind Gunhammer and threw him back into the cell, over the toilet and towards the wall. Gunhammer immediately got up and came at the officers at the door. Gunhammer and the officers then struggled and the officers pushed Gunhammer towards the wall and toilet area, so that Gunhammer ended

up straddling the toilet. Officer Gaylord controlled Gunhammer's left arm. Officer Soss then punched Gunhammer with his right fist eight (8) times on the left side of his face/head area. When Gunhammer covered up his face/head area with his free right hand, Officer Soss then punched Gunhammer four (4) times in the torso area with his left fist. Gunhammer again moved his right hand and Officer Soss punched Gunhammer again on the left side of the face/head area two (2) more times. Then Officer Gaylord said "Soss, Soss!" and Officer Soss reacted to this and stopped punching Gunhammer. Officers Soss and Gaylord then let go of Gunhammer and then the officers backed out of the cell.

Based on their experience in law enforcement, Deputy Conway and others in the Sheriff's Office, do not believe that the amount of force used by Soss was justified in order for Soss to control Gunhammer under the circumstances.
