On or about the 11th day of March, Helena Montana Police Officers responded to the St. Peters hospital for the report of a two year old boy, KT, who had several bruises on his body and scratches on his face.

Officers met with Jordan Terrio, the mother of the child. Jordan stated she picked up her son from his father's residence in Missoula County on the 11th day of March, 2013. KT had been staying with his father since the 1st day of March, 2013.

Jordan noticed scratches on KT's face and asked Kye what had happened. Kye stated, "I hit him too hard." Jordan changed KT's pants and notices several bruises on KT's back, leg and buttocks. Jordan asked KT what happened and KT said he was in trouble and "Daddy hit me." Jordan also informed law enforcement that Amy Sparling, Kye's mother, had recently skyped with Kye and KT. Amy inquired about the scratches on KT's face and Kye told her that he had hit KT too hard.

Helena Police Officer Struble spoke with ER Doctor Madill who stated he examined KT and observed bruises on his back and buttocks and that they appeared to be approximately two to three days old. Missoula City Detective Blood reviewed the case file sent from Helena and the photos taken of KT at the hospital. He reported KT had bruises on his cheek, shoulder, back, armpit, leg and buttocks.

Detective Blood spoke with Jordan who stated Kye had left Missoula and was currently in Great Falls, MT.
