COMPLAINT

PATRICIA C. BOWER, Deputy Missoula County Attorney, being duly sworn, deposes and says that on or about and between the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2003 and the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2004, at Missoula County, the above-named Defendant committed the offense(s) of SEXUAL INTERCOURSE WITHOUT CONSENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. §45-5-503, punishable by imprisonment in a state prison for a term of 100 years, because the victim was 12 years of age or younger and the offender was 18 years of age or older at the time of the offense, and a fine not to exceed \$50,000.

The facts constituting the offense(s) are:


On or about and between the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2003 and the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2004, the above-named Defendant knowingly had sexual intercourse with Jane Doe, without consent, by penetrating her vagina with his penis. Jane Doe was under the age of 12 at the time of the offense and Defendant was over the age of 18.

PATRICIA C. BOWER, Deputy County Attorney of Missoula County,

Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of STANFORD ALLEN LEWIS for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

The Missoula Police Department received a packet of materials from Detective Gabriel Otero of the Kingman, AZ Police Department in November of 2011. The materials included a report and follow up regarding a complaint received from Jane Doe's mother. Jane Doe's mother made a report to the Kingman Police Department about her daughter, Jane Doe, being the victim of

sexual assault by Defendant Stanford Lewis. Detective Otero completed an investigation, including interviews with all parties involved. As a result of Detective Otero's investigation, Defendant was charged and convicted of Sexual Abuse of a Minor under Fifteen Years of Age, a Class 3 Felony, in Mohave County, AZ. Detective Katie Petersen of the Missoula City Police Department was assigned this case for follow up.

During Jane Doe's interview, Jane Doe told Detective Otero about an incident that occurred around the summer of 2004 in Missoula County. She described an incident when Jane Doe, her sister and her sister's husband (Defendant) were staying in the basement of a friend's house. According to Detective Otero's report, Jane Doe stated the three of them usually slept in the same bed together; she would sleep in the middle. Jane Doe was 6 or 7 years old at this time, and Defendant was over the age of 18. Jane Doe reported that one night she woke up in extreme pain. She was on her side facing Defendant with her leg up over him. Defendant was putting his penis into her vagina. Jane Doe pushed him away and went into the bathroom. She had difficulty urinating and observed blood on the toilet paper.


