investigation of TRAVIS DAVID CROSBY for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 13th day of May, 2013, Missoula City Police and Fire Department personnel responded to a fire at an apartment complex located at 1319 E. Broadway in Missoula. The apartment complex is owned by

. Missoula Housing Authority and housed a number of disabled tenants who had to be evacuated by fire personnel. Before it was extinguished, the fire consumed several apartments in the building.

Detective Denton and fire investigators began investigating the source and cause of the fire. Residents of the building told Detective Denton that the tenant in Apartment 307, Travis Crosby, had admitted starting the fire. Fire investigators subsequently determined that the fire had in fact started in Apartment 307.

Detective Denton learned that there had been ongoing problems with Crosby in the building and that he had been served with a notice of eviction. Detective Denton was told that Crosby had been angry about the eviction and had made statements about wanting to burn the apartment complex down.

Crosby was located and interviewed. He initially claimed that his cousin had started the fire with a cigarette. He subsequently admitted that his cousin was not at his apartment. Crosby then admitted deliberately starting the fire by lighting a chair in his apartment on fire with matches. He said that he had started the fire because he was very angry.

A representative of the Missoula Housing informed Detective Denton that fire damages were going to total 3-5 million dollars.
