26 Cross Roads Truck Stop and Travel Plaza, of money, she purposely or  
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
1 knowingly obtained or exerted unauthorized control over more than

15 M. SHAUN DONOVAN, Deputy County Attorney of Missoula County,  
16 Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

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18 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the  
19 investigation of JURINDA MARIE SCHWEIGERT for allegedly committing  
20 the offense set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information  
21 contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify  
22 charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying  
23 complaint.  
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26 On July 10, 2013, Christopher Johnson, manager of the Cross Roads  
27 Truck Stop and Travel Plaza west of Missoula, reported he had discovered  
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1 a scheme in which an employee of the truck stop, Jurinda Schwiegert, who  
2 had been working as a cashier since October 2012, had been voiding cash  
3 sales, and taking and keeping for herself funds paid by customers for  
4 merchandise sold by the business. According to Mr. Johnson, a review of  
5 store video and Ms. Schweigert's individual sales transaction log shows  
6 that during the period from April 9, 2013 to July 9, 2013, the Defendant  
7 voided cash sales in the amount of \$11,212.36. Video of many of those  
8 transactions shows the Defendant voiding the sales after the customer  
9 leaves the premises and then pocketing the "extra" money at the end of her  
10 shift to avoid her till being long on cash. The sales voided by the Defendant  
11 were limited almost exclusively to cash transactions.  
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16  
17 Mr. Johnson reports that on July 9, 2013, after discovering the  
18 embezzlement by Ms. Schweigert, and determining her till that day was  
19 \$27.31 long on cash, he confronted her about stealing cash from the  
20 business. The Defendant stated her till was long because she had put \$25  
21 of her own cash into the till, anticipating purchasing gas for her vehicle later  
22 in the day. A review of the store video does not show her putting any of her  
23 personal funds into the cash register during her shift. It does show cash  
24 sale voids by the Defendant during the shift of approximately \$27.
