This matter came before the Court for defendant's Change of Plea Hearing. Upon inquiry by the Court, the parties are prepared to proceed and this change of plea is not pursuant to a Plea Agreement.

The Defendant is sworn and testifies to direct examination by the Court. The Court discusses the maximum punishment in this matter and explains lesser included charges.

The Defendant pleads Guilty but Mentally Ill and his plea is entered for the record.

The Court finds the Defendant guilty of Count I- Deliberate Homicide, a felony, Count II- Attempted Deliberate Homicide, a felony, Count III- Aggravated Burglary, a felony and Count IV- Robbery, a felony.

The Court orders a Pre-Sentence Investigation and sets this matter for Sentencing on November 5, 2013 at 10:00 a.m.

The State advises that now that the Defendant has pled Guilty, but Mentally Ill, an evaluation by Montana State hospital must be completed to be included in the PSI.

The Court advises that a total of three reports shall be included in the PSI.
