Missoula County Elections Office Promotes National Voter Registration Day

WHAT:

On Tuesday, September 24, 2013, the Missoula County Elections Office will host a National Voter Registration Day event at the Missoula County courthouse. The event is part of a massive 50-state effort to register thousands of voters before Election Day, November 5, 2013. In an effort to reach more public traffic in the courthouse, the Elections Office will staff a customer service table in the common area of the first floor of the annex. The theme for this year's National Voter Registration Day represents the importance of off-year elections and is titled "Millions of people will vote this year. Will you?"

WHY:

With federal elections occurring every two years, Missoula County wants to highlight the importance of off year elections held on odd number years. The Municipal Election on November 5th, 2013 is fast approaching and we want to provide every opportunity for the citizens of Missoula to vote! October 7th at 5:00 p.m. marks the close of voter registration for the Municipal Election which is being conducted by mail. Ballots are automatically mailed to active and provisionally registered voters. September 24th is a great opportunity to update your information, check your mailing address on file with our office, or register to vote.
