

The facts constituting the offense are: COUNT I: On or about the 4th day of September, 2013, the above-named defendant knowingly possessed visual or print medium, including a medium by use of electronic communication in which a child is engaged in sexual conduct, actual or simulated.

25	On or about the 4 th day of September, 2013, Tracy Templin reported	

to law enforcement that she had found nude pictures of what appeared to

be underage females on a computer that a friend of hers, Matthew Tack, had loaned her.

Detective Shermer went to Templin's apartment in Missoula and viewed the images. He noted that there were a number of pictures that appeared to depict a nude underage female. There were also pictures of the same female clothed. In one of the pictures she was wearing a sweatshirt with the logo of a middle school in Kentucky.

Tack was interviewed and admitted that he had possessed the pictures. However, he claimed that he believed the female was 18 years of age.

Detective Shermer contacted the middle school in Kentucky associated with the logo on the female's shirt. The school resource officer at the school as able to identify her. Detective Shermer interviewed the female. She stated that she had been involved in an online relationship with Tack. She said that she had told him that she was 13 and that the two of them were friends on Facebook and her age was clear on her Facebook page. She said that she had sent Tack nude images of herself at his request.

Further investigation of Tack's online activities showed that he had been involved with a number of underage girls and had solicited them to send sexually explicit photographs of themselves.
