BOWER, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 16th day of November, 2013, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT -BODILY INJURY, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-202, punishable by 20 years MSP and a \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 1ST OFFENSE, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[1st], punishable by not less than 24 hours or more than one year MCDF and/or a fine not less than \$100 or more than \$1000; and COUNT III: DISORDERLY CONDUCT, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-8-101(2), punishable by 10 days MCDF and/or

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 16th day of November, 2013, the abovenamed Defendant purposely or knowingly caused serious bodily injury to Debra Kluesner and/or purposely or knowingly, with the use of physical force or contact, caused reasonable apprehension of serious bodily injury or death in Debra Kluesner by choking her.

COUNT II: On or about the 16th day of November, 2013, the abovenamed Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to and/or reasonable apprehension of bodily injury in Ann Marie Wilson, his wife of 6 months, by grabbing Ann by her hair, shoving her onto a nearby sofa and/or yelling.

COUNT III: On or about the 16th day of November, 2013, the abovenamed Defendant knowingly disturbed the peace by using threatening, profane, or abusive language toward officers and medical personnel.

Officer Campbell's Report:

On the above date and time I responded to 1717 Wyoming #3 for a physical disturbance, male vs female. Prior to arrival dispatch advised the male had left the residence, but was attempting to reenter thru a window. Upon arrival dispatch advised the male had left the area, possibly to a neighboring trailer. While other arriving Officers checked the area for the male I proceeded inside #3.

Inside trailer #3 I was met by Ann Marie Wilson. With her was an older female later identified as Debra Kluesner, her landlord (also a resident). According to Ann, her husband, Howard Finerfrock, was heavily intoxicated, and got upset at her when attempting to wake him in their bedroom. Ann explained Howard had been out drinking earlier, also explaining he was on Probation, and shouldn't have been drinking to any extent. Ann stated Howard got angry with her for waking him up, and began screaming at her, still in the bedroom. Ann stated that while Howard was standing in the bedroom, he urinated himself, and the carpet beneath him.

Ann stated their live-in landlord, Debra, overheard the verbal disturbance and came into the bedroom, confronting Howard about his yelling. At this time Debra interjected. She stated she came into the

bedroom and told Howard he needed to leave, that she wasn't going to tolerate his yelling. Debra stated Howard turned towards her, got face to face with her, and began screaming "You fucking cunt! You're the biggest police snitch in this neighborhood you fucking bitch!" Debra continued to demand that Howard leave, at which point, according to Debra, Howard grabbed her by her throat with his right hand, at the front of her throat. She explained Howard was "choking me". During this struggle, Debra stated she was pressed against a nearby wall. Debra stated all she could think to do was try and swing at him, but that she was unable to break his grip. Debra stated she then began grabbing for something to strike Howard with, knowing there was a light stand nearby. Debra stated she felt a rock on the stand, and grabbed it. She explained the rock, approximately 4 inches by 1.5 inches, was a "memento" given to her that she kept. Debra stated she was able to grab the rock, enclose it in her fist, then strike Howard using a "hammer" motion with part of the rock sticking out, striking him on the side of his forehead.

Debra stated that at the same time, Ann was trying to break Howard away from her, at which point he turned and grabbed hold of Ann by her hair and shoved her onto a nearby sofa. Debra stated she then called 911.

Howard turned and shoved her down on the sofa as well. He then shouted more profanities and left the trailer.

At this point EMS arrived and began evaluating Debra. While they did this I spoke further with Ann. She witnessed Howard, her husband of 6 months, grabbing Debra by the throat, and Debra in turn striking him with the rock. Ann stated she attempted to separate the two when Howard grabbed her by her hair and shoved her down to the sofa. Ann stated she wasn't injured, and I didn't observe any injuries, nor did she complain of pain. however, Ann stated she was apprehensive Howard could get more physically violent with her and Debra, given his intoxication and his attempting at "choking" Debra. I provided Ann with a notice to victims form.

At this time I overheard Officer Vreeland say he had located Howard, and was transporting him to the MCDC for Probation Violation. ...

EMS transported Debra to St. Pats ER. I proceeded there where I spoke further with Debra. With regard to being "choked" by Howard, Debra stated she began "seeing stars", and thought his intention was "to keep me from talking anymore". Debra stated she became frantic, knowing she had to do something to break his grip. She stated she hit Howard with the rock while Ann pulled him off of her. She recalled Howard shoving Ann on the

couch, but wasn't sure whether he grabbed her by her hair. She stated she got shoved down on the couch as well before he left. With regard to the attempted reentry thru a window, Debra said he banged on a window shouting profanity, but didn't enter or break a window.

Officer Vreeland's Report:

I responded with Lt Bouchee, CpI Campbell and Officer Harrington for a disturbance involving a male and two females at 1717 Wyoming Streets trailer number 3. While in route, I was informed the male was attempting to break into the trailer through a window. Fire and medical had staged because one of the females had been strangled.

Cpl Campbell and Lt. Bouchee arrived prior to me and Cpl Campbell went to trailer number 3 where the two female victims were located. Lt Bouchee and I went to make contact with the male suspect, identified as Howard Finerfrock, who may have went into trailer number 2.

Lt Bouchee knocked loudly on the front door of trailer number 2 while I watched the back of the trailer. After several minuets of knocking, we were unable to get anybody to answer the front door. Lt. Bouchee went back towards where CpI Campbell was with the two females and I attempted to locate the male suspect.

I located the male, Howard Finerfrock sitting in a pickup truck on the street in front of the trailers. He had a small amount of blood coming out from above his left eye. I had him roll his window down and I was able to smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming off his breath and person.

I asked him what his first name was and he replied "Howard" and that I knew who the "fuck" he was. I asked him to step out of his vehicle and he did so. I told him I wanted medical to take a look at his eye and he told me words to the effect that I didn't give a fuck about him. Howard was very intoxicated and was slurring his words. He was uncooperative with the medical staff who were attempting to look at his eye. He was using profane and abusive language directed at them and when he was asked to spell his name he spelled it "FINERFROC fucking K".

Howard informed me he was on probation and I confirmed he was for theft and assault. Howard continued to yell and use profane language directed at the medical staff and at me. He was loud enough to disturb several other people in the trailer court and would not lower his voice although I told him to.

I arrested him for Disorderly Conduct and Probation Violation. Abby Gruber who was the on call probation officer requested a PV Hold and a breath sample to determine his blood alcohol. I transported him to the jail.

He remained uncooperative and threatened me several times. He told me to watch out for him when he got out of jail. He also told me to go "fuck myself" called me a "bald headed mother fucker" and that "I never had any pussy".

I read to him the standing order of no contact. He attempted to yell over me during the entire time I was reading it to him. ... He refused to provide a breath sample.
