AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

SHAWN THOMAS, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

SS

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of MATTHEW LLOYD VOEKS for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about November 18, 2013, Missoula City Police Officers responded to the Colonial Apartments on West Broadway in Missoula for a reported sexual assault. Jane Doe reported that her roommate, Matthew

 Voeks, had raped her. Jane was visibly upset and crying. Jane stated that she got drunk the other night (determined to be Saturday, November 16, 2013) and woke up with her pants down and Matthew on top of her. Jane also lives with her boyfriend Carl, but Carl was not home at the time. Jane said she was too embarrassed to tell her boyfriend what had happened on Sunday. On Monday morning she told Voeks to get out because he had taken advantage of her.

Voeks was also on scene when officers arrived and said he did not force Jane to have sex with him. Voeks admitted he was alone with Jane in the apartment on November 16, 2013 and Carl was not there. Voeks claimed that Jane had at least four 16 ounce beers and then passed out. She later woke up and asked him to have sex with her. He initially said no, but Jane kept pressing him and told him to take off his pants. Voeks then claimed he had consensual sex with Jane.

Voeks was transported to the Missoula City Police Department and interviewed by Detective Jamie Merifield. During that interview he admitted that Jane was too intoxicated to give consent to have sex with him that night, that he had taken advantage of her level of intoxication, and that he had made a bad decision.

At the conclusion of the interview Voeks was placed under arrest and transported to the Missoula County Detention Facility. On the way to the Detention Facility he said he knew he was in trouble as soon as he saw law enforcement pull up.
