

JASON MARKS, Assistant Chief Deputy County Attorney, deposes
and says that on or about November 27, 2013, in Missoula County, the
Defendant committed the offense of CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT
ROBBERY, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann.
§§ 45-5-401 and 45-4-102, punishable by not less than 2 or more than 40
years MSP and a \$50,000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

On or about the 27th day of November, 2013, the above-named Defendant
with the purpose that a Robbery be committed, agreed with another to the
commission of the offense and an act in furtherance of the offense was
done.

14 JASON MARKS, Assistant Chief Deputy County Attorney, Montana,
15 being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:
16

17 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the
18 investigation of JUSTIN MICHAEL HOLDSTHEENEMY for allegedly
19 committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the
20 information obtained from law enforcement, if true, believe probable cause
21 exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the
22 accompanying complaint.

25 On the 27th day of November, 2013, a Missoula Drug Task Force
26 (MDTF) officer, working undercover arranged to buy methamphetamine from
27 Jazmine Beehler. They agreed upon a time and location to conduct the

1 transaction. The officer responded to the designated location at the
2 Rosauer's parking lot, in Missoula, Montana.
3

4 While sitting in his vehicle, the officer was approached on the
5 passenger side by two males. One of the males was Joshua Robinson. The
6 detective inquired where Beehler was and Robinson stated she was going to
7 meet him there.
8

9 The officer stated that he only wished to deal with one of the individuals
10 and the other male walked away. Robinson told the officer to turn his vehicle
11 off and Robinson got in the officer's vehicle. Robinson asked to see the cash
12 before he provided the product. The officer showed him the money.
13 Robinson pulled out a flashlight and acted as if he were going to get out the
14 drugs.
15

16 Robinson then turned to the officer and produced a pistol from his right
17 front pocket. Robinson told the officer to give him the money. Robinson
18 pointed the gun directly at the officer and told him to put his hands up. The
19 officer produced a gun and Robinson shot the officer in an exchange of
20 gunfire.


22 Subsequent investigation revealed that Robinson fired two shots from
23 his handgun and a third round jammed in the gun.

1 Robinson was transported to the hospital until he was medically
2 cleared. He was then transported to the Missoula City Police Station.
3
4 Robinson was advised of his rights and agreed to speak with law
5 enforcement. Robinson admitted that he had agreed to rob a male who was
6 going to conduct a drug deal with a female named Jazmine (Beehler).
7
8 Robinson said that he was driven to the area by Beehler. They met a
9 Hispanic male, seemingly known to Beehler, who was to assist in the
10 robbery. According to Robinson, the Hispanic male provided Robinson with
11 a semi-automatic handgun, gloves and a bandana.


14 During an interview with Beehler, she admitted that she and others
15 discussed robbing the officer instead of conducting the drug deal. Beehler
16 stated she did not want to be involved in robbing the male, but Rachelle
17 (Kolden) said she would "handle it" and would do it with "Joker" (Robinson)
18 and the Hispanic male. Beehler stated Kolden drove them, with Beehler in
19 backseat with "Joker" and the Hispanic male was in the front passenger
20 seat, to the area of the planned drug rip in a gold or silver passenger car.

22 Beehler stated she got into the front passenger seat after they dropped of
23 "Joker" and the Hispanic male. Beehler stated Kolden had given a cell
24 phone to "Joker" and the plan was for them to pick "Joker" and the Hispanic

1 male up after they did the drug rip on the male. Beehler stated she and
2 Kolden remained in the area of the car wash to wait for the phone call.
3

4 Kolden was interviewed on December 1, 2013. She admitted that she
5 was with Beehler and Robinson and a Native American male named Justin
6 Holdstheenemy on November 27, 2013. She admitted they all discussed
7 the plan to rob the officer. Beehler and Kolden picked Holdstheenemy up
8 after the incident. He stated that he had heard five shots fired and then
9 fled.
