over property of the person's employer or over property entrusted to the
person or purposely or knowingly obtained by deception control over

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of LUCAS LEE KIBLER for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the abovenamed defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December, 2013, Missoula City Police
Officer Mulligan responded to Walmart on 93 South in Missoula County for
the report of a theft by an employee. Upon arrival Officer Mulligan spoke
with Manager Phillip Sperry. Sperry stated Kibler had worked at the

registers of Walmart and between October 30, 2013 and November 30, 2013, Kibler had stolen approximately \$3150.00. Sperry provided surveillance recordings that he stated documented the thefts. Kibler was interviewed and admitted to the thefts. He agreed that the amount would be roughly \$3150.
