Code Ann. 45-4-102 and 45-5-625, punishable by Life or 100 years MSP and a \$10,000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 18th day of December, 2013, the abovenamed Defendant, with the purpose that the offense of Sexual Abuse of Children be committed, agreed with Chad Briggs to the commission of the offense and an act in furtherance of the agreement was committed in that the Defendant and Chad Briggs traveled to a house in Missoula for a sexual encounter with what they believed was a 12 year old child.

17	I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the	
18 19	investigation of JENNA ELIZABETH DAVIS for allegedly committing the	
20	offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information	
21 22	contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify	
23	charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying	
24	complaint.	
25 26	On or about the 17 <sup>th</sup> day of December, 2013, the Montana Internet	
27	Crimes Against Children task force along with members of the Missoula	
28	Police Department, Missoula County S	Sheriff's Department, and Flathead

County Sheriff's Department began a sting operation targeting people seeking to have sex with underage girls. They posted ads on Craigslist and Backpage purporting to be posted by a woman willing to make a 12 year old female relative available for sexual encounters. Officers then posed as the woman and her 12 year old relative in text message exchanges and phone conversations with people responding to the ads.

On December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013, Jenna Davis responded to one of the Craigslist ads. She indicated that her boyfriend, Chad Brigg, would be interested in helping the 12 year old girl, who was the apparent subject of the ad, lose her virginity. She said that Briggs had been involved in a prior sexual encounter with an underage girl and it had been a positive experience. She indicated that she was calling to make sure that the Craigslist posting was legitimate.

Subsequently Chad Briggs called the undercover detective. He assured the detective that he would bring condoms and be gentle with the 12 year old. He was given the address of the house being used for the operation.

Shortly after 9 p.m. Davis contacted the undercover detective and indicated that she and Briggs were on their way. She indicated that Briggs was concerned that nerves might interfere with his ability to get an erection

1	and asked if it would be okay if she was in the room during the encounter to		
3	help Briggs get ready. Both Davis and Briggs arrived at the house in		
4	Missoula and were taken into custody.
