On or about the 12th day of April, 2013, Missoula City Police and Fire Department responded to a structure fire at the Senior Citizen's Center at

7

 705 S. Higgins in Missoula. Before it was extinguished the fire caused approximately \$11,000 in damage.

Fire inspectors determined that the cause of the fire was non-accidental. Detective Denton was assigned the case for investigation. He obtained surveillance video of three people who had been together in the area around the time the fire started. Through subsequent investigation he identified them as Sarah Washington and Sean Reinhart. Both Washington and Reinhart were interviewed and said that they had been with a man named Birch Bergeson. They said that he had been behaving strangely at the time and had gone off by himself in the area of the Senior Citizen's Center. Washington said that Bergeson had subsequently admitted to her that he had started the fire.

Detective Denton went to Bergeson's last known places of employment in an attempt to interview him. Detective Denton learned that Bergeson had abruptly stopped coming to work after the fire. It was believed he had left town for Billings.

Detective Denton called Bergeson's last known phone number. A man identifying himself as Birch Bergeson answered the phone. He said that he could not talk at that time. Detective Denton has since left several messages at that number with no return calls.
