SHAUN DONOVAN, Deputy Missoula County Attorney, deposes and says that between December 2013 and June, 2014, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: ASSAULT ON A MINOR, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-212, punishable by 5 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: ASSAULT ON A MINOR, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-212, punishable by 5 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine and COUNT III: ASSAULT ON A MINOR, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. **AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE** 

M. SHAUN DONOVAN, Deputy Missoula County Attorney, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of CHARLOTTE MARIE SANCHEZ for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On June 17, 2014 Missoula Police Detective Katherine Peterson was advised by personnel from the Child and Family Services Division of the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services that a few days earlier, 13 year old "A.S." and her 10 year old sister, "L.C.," were forensically interviewed at the First Step Resource Center in Missoula by Nurse Practitioner Mary Pat Hanson.

According to the information supplied to Detective Peterson by First Step, the girls, and their 12 year old brother, "T.C.," had been returned to the care of their mother, Charlotte Sanchez, in December 2013. The girls each disclosed that since that time

they had been routinely slapped and punched by their mother who also regularly pulled their hair. A.S. said she had also been shoved into a shower and stabbed in the head. Numerous bruises were found on her body consistent with physical abuse including a possible scalp wound. L.C. stated she had also been struck with the metal part of her mother's belt and that Ms. Sanchez physically punished AS, who suffers from a debilitating medical condition, more frequently than L.C..

On June 17, 2014, 12 year old TC was interviewed at First Step and confirmed physical abuse by his mother who "gets really mad" and "tries to hit us," which he said he most often avoids by running away. He described an incident about one month earlier which was "scary" where the Defendant pulled him into the house, put her arm around his neck from behind, and began punching him in the head. He described being "choked" and quoted his mother as saying, "You better start respecting me!" TC said it felt like "a burn when you touch a hot stove" when his mother hit him with the metal part of her belt and that, despite his pulling up his bed covers to protect himself, the attack left him with little red welts on his arms. He claimed that afterward, when he was crying, his mother became "exhausted" and told him she was sorry.
