They spoke with Jessica Brewer on the phone who stated her brother, Michael Brewer had gotten upset with her. She stated he grabbed both sides of her collar and strangled her with them by drawing them tightly together against her neck. She stated she could not breathe the whole time. She said she thought he would kill her, strangle her until she passed out or he would just stop. After Michael stopped strangling her, he stated, "What are you going to do about that?"
