COMPLAINT

Jennifer Clark, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 18th day of October, 2014, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of
COUNT I: BURGLARY, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-6-204(1), punishable by 20 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: ASSAULT WITH WEAPON, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-213, punishable by 20 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT III: CRIMINAL MISCHIEF, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-6-101(1)[1], punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$1,500 fine.


The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 18th day of October, 2014, the above-named Defendant knowingly entered or remained unlawfully in an occupied structure with the purpose to commit an offense therein, to wit: assault.

COUNT II: On or about the 18th day of October, 2014, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused reasonable apprehension of serious bodily injury in Rochelle Kohler by use of a weapon, a knife.

COUNT III: On or about the 18th day of October, 2014, the above-named Defendant committed the offense of criminal mischief by knowingly or purposely damaging a door belonging to Rochelle Kohler without consent.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On or about the 18TH day of October, 2014, Rochelle Kohler called 911 and reported that Ronald Hall had entered her house without permission and threatened to kill her and her dog with a butcher knife. She was afraid he would hurt her. When Officer Smith responded, he observed the defendant running from the house. He was later located in a field nearby. Officer Smith also observed that the aluminum screen door he had entered Rochelle's house through was broken and Rochelle advised him that it was not broken before Hall entered. The knife was recovered from her house.
