AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

KIRSTEN H. PABST, Missoula County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of RALPH F. LOCKWOOD JR. for allegedly committing the offense set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint. Specifically,

On February 15, 2015, around 5:00 p.m., Missoula Police Officers responded to the Motel 6 on East Broadway, Missoula, to the report of a structure fire with flames and smoke coming out of a room. When Sgt. JC Denton arrived, firefighters from the Missoula Fire Department were already in the room. Denton saw a spilled bottle of rum on the floor and another bottle of rum on the night stand. Denton saw that the fire had burned the left side and edge of the mattress. The area near the head of the bed was burned with circular burn marks indicating an accelerant had been used. Several used

 matches were lying on the bed. The fire also singed the paint on the wall and the nightstand.

Denton spoke to the defendant who initially said that something caught on fire when he was lying down smoking cigarettes. He soon admitted to starting the fire on purpose because he was angry at his girlfriend. He claimed to have put the fire out. However, employees of Motel 6, who had come into the room to see the left side of the bed in flames and the defendant standing naked at the foot of the bed staring into the fire, actually extinguished the fire. They told the defendant to put on some clothes and go outside.

According to Denton, the fire was contained to one room but there were 18 people renting rooms in that section of the motel. Denton expressed concern that starting a fire inside of a motel room, using accelerants, created a substantial risk of bodily injury or death to others.
