AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

SUZY BOYLAN, Assistant Chief Criminal County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of ANDREW KNUTSON for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 18th day of May, 2015, the mother of 15 year-old Jane Doe reported to the Missoula City Police Department that the above-named Defendant raped Jane Doe at her home. Jane Doe's mother advised that Defendant asked her if he could date Jane Doe. The mother said no and that it would be inappropriate because Defendant is 19. A short time later, the mother noticed some behavioral changes in her daughter and suspected something had happened. She found a journal belonging to

Defendant that appeared to confirm her suspicions. When she asked Jane Doe about it, Jane Doe reported the Defendant had sex with her.

Jane Doe reported that she initially resisted Defendant's advances but then gave in. In an interview at First Step, Jane Doe stated Defendant penetrated her vagina with his penis and his tongue. Afterwards, she felt dirty and took a shower, spending about an hour in the shower and using half a bottle of body wash to feel clean. She said Defendant knew she was 15 because he was at her 15th birthday party. She described becoming withdrawn and having thoughts of harming herself after the rape.

On or about June 11, 2015, Detective Bob Franke received information that Defendant was at City Hall, where a hearing was scheduled for an Order of Protection against him obtained by Jane Doe's mother. Defendant agreed to an interview with Detective Franke.

Defendant initially denied raping Jane Doe and said the relationship never went beyond kissing. He said Jane Doe asked him if they could go out. Defendant told her it wasn't a good idea because Jane Doe's mother probably wouldn't let her go out with him because he is 19. Defendant eventually admitted he penetrated Jane Doe's vagina with his penis and tongue.

Investigation is continuing into possible additional charges involving another underage victim.
