**COMPLAINT** 

SUZY BOYLAN, Assistant Chief Criminal County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 14th day of August, 2015, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: AGGRAVATED BURGLARY, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-6-204(2), punishable by 40 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: ASSAULT - BODILY INJURY, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-201, punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$500 fine; COUNT III: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 1ST OFFENSE, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[1st], punishable by not less than 24 hours or more than one year MCDF and/or a fine not less than \$100 or more than \$1000.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 14th day of August, 2015, the above-named

Defendant knowingly entered or remained unlawfully in an occupied structure and knowingly or purposely committed an offense within that structure, and in effecting entry or in the course of committing the offense of in immediately flight after effecting entry or

committing the offense, Defendant purposely or knowingly inflicted or attempted to inflict bodily injury, by assaulting Justin Chilcott and/or Jane Doe.

COUNT II: On or about the 14th day of August, 2015, the above-named

Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to another, Justin Chilcott, by
striking him in the face.

COUNT III: On or about the 14th day of August, 2015, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to Jane Doe, a partner, by grabbing her hip.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

SUZY BOYLAN, Assistant Chief Criminal County Attorney, Montana, being first

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of EVERETT EUGENE NEUHAUS for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2015, officers were dispatched to a report of a burglary at a residence on 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue in Missoula. The above-named Defendant was identified as the suspect. Jane Doe, Defendant's former partner who had broken up with him the day before, reported she was laying clothes on a bed with a friend when Defendant walked into the bedroom, started yelling at her, and grabbed her by the right hip, causing pain. He yanked her off the bed. He then punched Justin Chilcott, Jane Doe's friend, in the face. Defendant then left the residence and started calling her and

texting her, threatening to destroy her belongings. Some of Jane Doe's belongings were located in the front yard.

Chilcott reported the same events as Jane Doe. His eye was bloodshot and he reported his face was numb and swollen.

Defendant was located by officers. He admitted being angry because Jane Doe had broken up with him the day before. He knew where she would be staying.

Defendant said he went through the front door because it was unlocked. He further admitted that he went to the back bedroom where he saw Jane Doe and Chilcott. He accused them of having sex. He said he grabbed Jane Doe by the legs, taking her of the bed. He then said he "smacked" Chilcott then left through the front door.

Other witnesses reported they saw Defendant enter the house through a window.
