COMPLAINT

SUZY BOYLAN, Assistant Chief Criminal County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 17th day of August, 2015, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 1ST OFFENSE, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[1st], punishable by not less than 24 hours or more than one year MCDF and/or a fine not less than \$100 or more than \$1000; COUNT II: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT - REASONABLE APPREHENSION, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-202, punishable by 20 years MSP and \$50,000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 16th day of August, 2015, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to Jane Doe, a partner, by repeatedly striking her.

COUNT II: On or about the 16th day of August, 2015, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly, with the use of physical force or contact, caused reasonable apprehension of serious bodily injury or death in another, Jane Doe, by strangling her.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

SUZY BOYLAN, Assistant Chief Criminal County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

IN THE JUSTICE COURT OF THE STATE OF MONTANA,
IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF MISSOULA
BEFORE ______Keren A. Oracch , JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of DANIEL NICHOLAS REDMAN for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 17th day of August, 2015, officers responded to Jane Doe's workplace for a report of an assaulted that occurred the night before. Jane Doe reported that she and her partner, identified as the above-named Defendant, had an argument. Defendant struck her with an open hand on the side of her face, knocking her to the ground. He then began physically attacking her and hitting her all over her body. Jane Doe fought back and bloodied his nose at one point. Defendant then put her in a

"chokehold," strangling her with his arm around her neck. She said it felt like a really long time and that she couldn't breathe and thought, "I think I might die." She did not lose consciousness. Defendant then walked out of the room, and Jane Doe thought the assault was over.

Defendant then came back into the room screaming obscene names at her. He threw her down on the ground and started hitting her repeatedly. She was not able to call for help because Defendant took her phone and broke it. He then left the house, and she locked the door and locked herself in the bedroom with her children.

Jane Doe had at least 14 bruises on her body, on her buttocks, hips, thigh, eye, ears, and arms, and a large red spot in her eye.

Defendant was located and interviewed. He admitting to hitting Jane Doe and said she started clawing, scratching, biting and hitting him back. He could not explain why she had such severe bruising all over her body.
