JENNIFER CLARK, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 26th day of January, 2016, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-202, punishable by 20 years MSP and \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 1ST OFFENSE, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. ## AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

JENNIFER CLARK, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of JAMES MANUEL ROGERS for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On January 27, 2016, Deputies Evans and Schmill met Jane Doe at the Missoula City Police Department. She asked if she could speak to them in private. She had a shaky voice, trembling hands and appeared to be on the verge of tears. She stated that James Rogers, a man she had been dating since Halloween 2015, had hit her head on a bar stool and strangled her. Deputies observed a red knot on her forehead and redness on her neck.

She stated that Rogers became angry with her when she was out of the house for too-long. He came up behind her and placed his left arm across her neck and

braced it with his right arm over his left wrist. He pushed her down and caused her forehead to hit a bar stool. She stated she thought he would kill her. He previously had told her that he killed two other people. She stated that she was gasping for air and felt like her head would pop off.

Deputies observed swelling on the right side of her neck and throat. Her neck had red marks on both sides. She stated it was painful to swallow and the entire right side of her throat and around her neck hurt. She had a red abrasion across the outside of her right upper arm and a red mark shaped like a finger on the inside of her right upper arm. She had some scratches just above her elbow. Deputies observed what appeared to be petechiae in her lower lip consistent with strangling.
