COMPLAINT

BRIAN LOWNEY, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 19th day of February, 2016, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: CRIMINAL ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-207, punishable by 10 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 2ND OFFENSE, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[2nd], punishable by not less than 72 hours or more than one year MCDF and a fine not less than \$300 or more than \$1000.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 19th day of February, 2016, the above-named Defendant knowingly engaged in conduct that created a substantial risk of death or serious bodily injury to Jane Doe.

COUNT II: On or about the 19th day of February, 2016, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to Jane Doe, a partner.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

BRIAN LOWNEY, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of DANIEL JOSEPH MITCHELL IV for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On February 19, 2016, Jane Doe presented to the St. Patrick's Hospital Emergency Room reporting an assault at the hands of the Defendant. Doe, who is the Defendant's girlfriend and currently pregnant, reported that the Defendant strangled her multiple times while she was at the Defendant's house in Missoula County earlier that day. Doe indicated that she and the Defendant got into an argument, during which Doe was lying on the bed. Doe began to cry during the argument and rolled over onto her stomach. The Defendant then grabbed Doe by the back of the neck with his hands, and

began to push Doe's head into the pillow. Doe indicated she had a "hard time breathing and got dizzy" during this assault.

The Defendant let Doe up after 20-30 seconds, and Doe began to yell at him for assaulting her. In response, the Defendant grabbed Doe and threw her back on the bed and began strangling her again. Doe indicated that she began to lose consciousness during the second strangling, but did not fully black out. When the Defendant released her neck, Doe ran out the back door of the residence.

Doe indicated that she was feeling pain in her eyes, mouth, right temple area and both sides of her neck behind her ears. Later investigation revealed that Doe suffered multiple crushed tracheal rings in her esophagus from the assault. The Defendant has previously been convicted of Partner-Family Member Assault in 2007.
