BRIAN LOWNEY, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 30th day of May, 2016, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 3RD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[3rd+], punishable by not less than 30 days or more than 5 years MSP and/or a fine not less than \$500 or more than \$50,000; COUNT II: OBSTRUCTING PEACE OFFICER OR OTHER PUBLIC SERVANT, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-7-302(1), punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$500 fine; COUNT III: RESISTING ARREST, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-7-301, punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$500 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 30th day of May, 2016, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused reasonable apprehension of bodily injury in Jane Doe, a partner/family member.

COUNT II: On or about the 30th day of May, 2016, the above-named Defendant knowingly obstructed, impaired, or hindered the enforcement of the criminal law, the preservation of the peace, or the performance of a governmental function, including service of process by fleeing from the police.

COUNT III: On or about the 30th day of May, 2016, the above-named Defendant knowingly prevented or attempted to prevent members of the Missoula Police Department, peace officers, from effecting an arrest by: (a) using or threatening to use physical force or violence against the peace officer or another; or (b) using any other means which created a risk of causing physical injury to the peace officer or another.

BRIAN LOWNEY, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

Marie A Andersen_, JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of WESLEY JARED GARDINER for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On May 30, 2016, Missoula Police Department officers were called to a report of an assault on the 1400 block of West Broadway, Missoula County, MT. Officers

contacted Jane Doe, the Defendant's ex-girlfriend. Doe indicated she had travelled to the Defendant's home just prior to the police response to check on the Defendant's mental health. When the Defendant opened the door to his residence, he became angry that Doe was there and grabbed her by the throat. Doe indicated that the Defendant accused her of "sleeping around" and yelled at her that she was a "whore" while he was grabbing her by the throat. Doe indicated she did not feel pain in her throat, but told police that she was attempting to get away from the Defendant based on his actions.

A witness to the event related that he saw the Defendant pin Doe up against a white van with his arm pushing up against Doe's neck. The witness indicated that it appeared Doe "was hurting" and "having a hard time breathing". The witness indicated that the Defendant was yelling at Doe the entire time.

Two employees of a nearby business were also interviewed, as they interacted with Doe after the assault. Those employees indicated that Doe came into their business, and the Defendant followed her, yelling that he "dared" her to call the police and that he would have Doe "thrown in jail." The employees indicated that Doe was "clearly scared" of the Defendant. Doe later told the employees that the Defendant put her in a "choke hold".

Officers attempted to locate the Defendant, and found him walking on a nearby street. Officers ordered the Defendant to stop, but the Defendant ran from them. The Defendant eventually ran to the Clark Fork River, and waded into the river in an effort to reach an island in the middle of the river. The Defendant remained in the river for

approximately 50 minutes, refusing numerous commands to come out. Officers were finally able to convince the Defendant to come to shore.

Once on shore, officers attempted to place handcuffs on the Defendant.

However, the Defendant clenched his hands in a fist and held them to his chest, and would not comply with commands to put his hands behind his back. Officers attempted to force the Defendant's hands behind his back, but he resisted those efforts. Officers were finally able to handcuff the Defendant.
