JAMES MCCUBBIN, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 6th day of May, 2016, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS DRUGS WITH INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE - ANY DRUG OTHER THAN AN OPIATE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-9-103(3), punishable by 20 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: UNLAWFUL USE/POSSESSION OF PROPERTY SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL FORFEITURE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-9-206(1), punishable by 10 years MSP and forfeiture of property.

COUNT I: On or about the 6th day of May, 2016, the above-named Defendant knowingly possessed MARIJUANA, a SCHEDULE I dangerous drug, as defined in 50-32-101, with intent to distribute.

D. JAMES MCCUBBIN, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of STEVEN ELMER SPANBAUER for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 6th day of May, 2016, Missoula Sheriff's Deputies responded to a single vehicle crash on the exit from Interstate 90 at Mile Marker 89, in Missoula County, Montana. A male in the vicinity of the vehicle was identified as the driver, and confirmed to be Defendant STEVEN ELMER SPANBAUER.

Several bags of a substance consistent with the appearance of marijuana were observed by deputies near the vehicle, which had apparently rolled over in the crash. SPANBAUER was advised of his Miranda rights, and agreed to speak with deputies. SPANBAUER stated that a "dealer" had paid him to deliver the marijuana from Washington to a location further east that he would not state. SPANBAUER said that he was carrying approximately 35 pounds of marijuana, packaged in roughly eight ounce packages, and he believed he had 70 packages. SPANBAUER also stated that he had "edibles" as well, which consisted of cookies, candies and other homemade goods. SPANBAUER said that he would be paid "about \$1400" to deliver the marijuana.

SPANBAUER granted deputies consent to search the vehicle. A search of the vehicle and immediately surrounding area located the 70 packages of marijuana and marijuana edibles described by SPANBAUER. The packages of marijuana appeared to match SPANBAUER's described eight ounce estimate and bore names such as "Moby Dick", "Blue Dream", "Royal Kush" etc. The edibles consisted of commercial cookies and candies that had been purchased from "Smokane" in Spokane, WA, for approximately \$309, and other homemade baked goods. Also located was approximately \$546 in cash comprised of mostly \$10 bills that SPANBAUER claimed was his "gas money".
