Mac Bloom, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 27th

day of August, 2016, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT - REASONABLE APPREHENSION, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-202, punishable by 20 years MSP and \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 3RD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[3rd+], punishable by not less than 30 days or more than 5 years MSP and/or a fine not less than \$500 or more than \$50,000; COUNT III: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 3RD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[3rd+], punishable by not less than 30 days or more than 5 years MSP and/or a fine not less than \$500 or more than \$50,000.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 27th day of August, 2016, the above-named

Defendant purposely or knowingly, with the use of physical force or contact, caused reasonable apprehension of serious bodily injury or death in Jane Doe by strangling her and/or throwing her to the ground in their apartment.

COUNT II: On or about the 27th day of August, 2016, the above-named

Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to Jane Doe, his wife, when he struck her twice in the face in their apartment, a third or subsequent offense.

COUNT III: On or about the 27th day of August, 2016, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to M.M., his father-in-law, when he grabbed him by the throat and/or punched him in the face, a third or subsequent offense.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

MAC BLOOM, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly swom upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of MICHAEL ERIC ROMAS for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 27th day of August, 2016, at approximately 10:00 a.m., Officer Kaneff and Officer Malone, Missoula City Police Department, responded to a residence

regarding a reported disturbance. Upon arrival, they made contact with Jane Doe, who stated that her husband, Michael Romas (Defendant) assaulted her earlier that day. She explained that she just found out that her grandmother had been diagnosed with a life-threatening illness so she asked Defendant to accompany her to the hospital for a visit. Defendant refused and Doe began to cry. Defendant then lost his temper and struck her in the face twice—once with and open palm and once with a closed fist. Officer Kaneff observed that Doe had a "fresh" and "swelling" black eye. Doe reported feeling pain when she was struck.

Doe also stated that at some point that morning Defendant grabbed her by the throat and threw her to the ground. She reported that Defendant has done this before. On this occasion, Doe had momentary trouble breathing and feared for her life and the life of her young daughter, who was also present. Office Malone observed that Doe had red marks on her neck consistent with strangulation.

After the strangulation, Doe called her father, M.M. for help. M.M. drove to the residence to pick up Doe and Doe's daughter. When he arrived, he told Defendant to never touch his daughter again. At that point, Defendant grabbed M.M. by the throat and punched him in the face, causing pain and injury. Officer Malone was unable to observe marks on M.M.'s throat, but noted that he did not get a careful look.

Next, Officer Kaneff and Officer Malone responded to Defendant's location and asked him to provide a statement. Defendant claimed that he never touched Doe and that her black eye came from falling in the shower. Defendant said that M.M. entered his residence and "attacked him." Defendant stated that he did not hit M.M. but did shove him

to the ground. Officer Kaneff observed that Defendant's knuckles were red, which contradicted his story. Defendant was then placed under arrest and transported to jail.
