disturbance. There, he met with John Doe. Upon meeting with Doe, Deputy Terrill immediately observed a small cut on the right side of Doe's nose and dried blood around his mouth. Doe reported that he lives on Speedway Avenue with his girlfriend, Jaimie Clark ("Defendant"). Defendant had not been home for the last several days, but returned to the house at approximately 4:00am. Defendant became irate when she couldn't find her stereo, which Defendant stated he had moved to a different room. Doe stated that Defendant began throwing candles and glass jars at Doe. After Doe stopped throwing items, Doe reported he sat on the couch when Defendant approached him with a machete and hit him several times. Doe stated that he covered his head and torso with his arms and legs as he was being struck. A struggle ensued when Doe tried to control Defendant and get her to stop hitting him. Defendant was eventually thrown to the couch, and the legs broke. Defendant then chased Doe into the kitchen and outside with the machete. Doe stated that Defendant hit him so many times the handle of the machete broke. Deputy Terrill located part of the handle outside of the residence. Doe further stated that he believed Defendant was going to kill him. After being chased outside. Doe reentered the residence to retrieve some items. Doe stated that Defendant then began punching him in the face.

Doe's injuries were photographed. He had a considerable welt on his left arm consistent with being struck with the flat of a machete. He also had similar injuries on his back.
