Code Ann. 21 45-5-622(3), punishable by 5 Years MSP and/or \$10,000 fine or if a child suffers serious 22 bodily injury 10 Years MSP and/or \$25,000 fine; COUNT II: SOLICITATION OF 23 24 TAMPERING WITH OR FABRICATING PHYSICAL EVIDENCE, a Felony, in violation of 25 Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-7-207 and 45-4-101, punishable by 10 years 26 MSP and/or \$50,000 fine. 27 The facts constituting the offense are: 28

COUNT I: On or about between the 1st day of April, 2017, and the 13th day of April, 2017, the above-named Defendant knowingly endangered the welfare of {L.M.}, a child under 18 years of age, by causing or permitting the child to inhale, be exposed to, have contact with, or ingest methamphetamine.

COUNT II: On or about the 13th day of April, 2017, with the purpose that the offense of Tampering with or Fabricating Physical Evidence be committed, the abovenamed Defendant believing that an official proceeding or investigation was pending or about to be instituted commanded family members to alter, destroy, conceal, or remove Facebook messages and the Defendant's Facebook account with the purpose to impair the availability of Facebook messages in such proceeding or investigation.

On or about the 12th day of April, 2017, Missoula 911 received a phone call

complex behind Westside lanes bowling alley. In the recorded call a male voice is audible providing the female caller with a license plate which she relays to the call taker, indicating the persons holding her at gunpoint are associated with the vehicle. The caller then disconnected and was unable to be re-contacted at that time. Missoula Police units respond and take report(s) from persons in the area of 230 S. Catlin St. stating that a gunshot had been heard in the area and a male had been observed running from the scene possibly carrying a weapon. Officers on scene located a fired .45ACP shell casing in the parking lot of 230 S. Catlin.

Detective Stonesifer was able to correlate the number the female used to call 911 with 17 year old {L.M.}. A confidential informant told Detective Stonesifer that {L.M.} was in a physically intimate romantic relationship with a 43 year old methamphetamine dealer named Cory Brumwell (AKA: Cory Kendall). Police located and stopped Kendall. It was noted that he was wearing a holster and there was a gun in his car. Kendall agreed to be interviewed by detectives regarding the incident at 230 S. Catlin. {L.M.} was also located and interviewed by detectives.

In addition to interviewing Kendall regarding the shooting, detectives also interviewed him regarding his relationship with {L.M.}. He admitted they were in a romantic and sexual relationship for the past two or three weeks. He denied suppling her with methamphetamine but did admit to taking her to purchase methamphetamine, allowing her to use his phone to arrange the purchase of methamphetamine, giving her money for methamphetamine, and to "keeping her safe" while she injected methamphetamine. When discussing methods of communication with {L.M.}, Kendall told detectives that there were messages between he and {L.M.} on his Facebook

Messenger account. Kendall was ultimately arrested on a charge of Endangering the Welfare of a child.

While in a holding cell at the jail, Kendall called family members and repeatedly requested that they log onto his Facebook account and delete the messages from his Facebook Messenger. When they refused to do that he asked them to remove his entire Facebook account. He also asked his mother to contact {L.M.} for him which she refused to do. A family member subsequently expressed to law enforcement that they were concerned that they would be tampering if they did what he asked.
