Code Ann. 45-5-207, punishable by 10 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: FLEEING FROM OR ELUDING A PEACE OFFICER, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 61-8-316(1) and (2)(a), punishable by 1 year MCDF and/or \$2.000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 6th day of June, 2017, the above-named Defendant knowingly engaged in conduct that created a substantial risk of death or serious bodily injury to other motorists on Highway 200, Interstate 90, and/or the Reserve Street exit

ramp when he drove at speeds reaching approximately 120 miles per hour, swerved between lanes, nearly collided with other vehicles, crashed into a guardrail, and/or otherwise drove in an extremely dangerous manner.

COUNT II: On or about the 6th day of June, 2017, the above-named Defendant, while operating a motor vehicle, a Dodge Dart, fled from or eluded a uniformed peace officer, Trooper Andersen, operating a police vehicle in the lawful performance of such officer's duties and who gave the Defendant a visual or audible signal by emergency light or siren directing the Defendant to stop the motor vehicle and such Defendant knowingly failed to obey such signal by increasing the speed of his motor vehicle, continuing at a speed that was 10 or more mph above the applicable speed limit, and/or otherwise fleeing from, eluding or attempting to flee from or elude. Trooper Andersen.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

STATE OF MONTANA) : ss County of Missoula)

MAC BLOOM, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of ANTHONY ROY WALLACE for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 6th day of June, 2017, Trooper Andersen, Montana Highway

Patrol, responded to Highway 200 near the Bonner School in an attempt to locate a silver

Dodge Dart driven by Anthony Wallace. Trooper Andersen learned that Wallace has a no bond warrant for his arrest. As Trooper Andersen passed through Bonner, he observed the Dart travelling westbound. He pulled behind the Dart and activated his overhead lights. The Dart immediately sped up to approximately 72 miles per hour in a 35 mile per hour zone. The Dart then crossed the centerline and forced an oncoming vehicle to the shoulder of the road.

The Dart continued Westbound onto Interstate 90, reaching speeds of up to 120 miles per hour. It swerved back and forth in an attempt to avoid spike strips that had been set out by other law enforcement officers, and at one point, swerved towards a marked patrol unit. When the Dart reached Missoula, it continued travelling at approximately 114 miles per hour in a 65 mile per hour zone. The dart nearly rearended a white SUV and then cut off a white pickup truck.

As the Dart travelled past the Orange Street exit, law enforcement successfully deployed a spike strip on the Dart's front tires. The Dart continued travelling at approximately 90 miles per hour past a motorcycle. At that point, the Dart's tires began to smoke and eventually both front tires came off their rims.

The Dart exited the Interstate using the Reserve Street off ramp at approximately 60 miles per hour. The off ramp was occupied by four other vehicles. The Dart then crashed into the guardrail on the right-hand side of the roadway. The driver was apprehended and confirmed to be Anthony Wallace.
