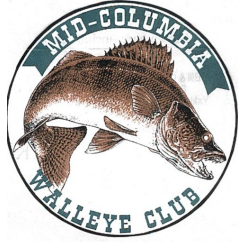

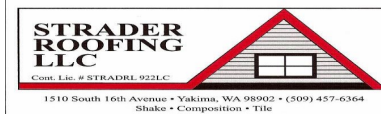

## Event Rules and Guidelines

1. Kids will need to arrive 30 minutes before their designated fishing time to check in, pick up their t-shirt and go through the educational areas.
2. Once this has been completed the families go to the staging area to pick up their rod and reel, then wait until the time of their fishing session.
3. At the beginning of their fishing session, families may then go to the spot of their choice. Due to limited fishing area, please limit number of non-fishing family members on the pathway around the pond. Non-fishing family members are welcome to sit on the hill or in the bleacher area to stay safely out of the way and watch.
4. The goal is for each participant to catch a fish. The folks that organize this event work hard to achieve that goal, yet there are circumstances beyond our control that may cause a few of the participants to not catch a fish. Contact a volunteer guide in an orange vest for assistance.
5. Parents are encouraged to help their child fish. However the child is the one that should be fishing.
6. No dogs or bicycles or strollers will be allowed in the fishing area, for safety considerations.
7. Once the event limit of two (2) fish is caught or the end of your session, each child will leave the fishing area and proceed to the cleaning station.
8. Parking is limited and if possible, use of community transit or carpooling is encouraged.
9. Registration form must be turned in to the Yakima Greenway Foundation no later than 5:00pm on April 25th. This program fills up rapidly, so register early.
10. Time slots are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. You will be notified by email, phone or mail of the fishing time. Once a registration form is completed these assignments cannot be changed.
11. A parent or legal guardian's signature is required for any child to participate in this program, no exceptions.

*Rods & reels may be donated back to the event for use next year, look for donation barrel.*

### **NO REFUND FOR ANY REASON**

Responsive Management will be conducting a survey for the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife 2 weeks before & 2 weeks after 4/27 to collect information from 250 entrants regarding our Kids' Fish-In affect on families in our community.
