



Maine Turnpike Authority WEEKLY LANE CLOSURE UPDATE September 18, 2016

The weekly travel forecast is intended to provide construction information to patrons of the Maine Turnpike. This schedule of lane closures is subject to change due to weather conditions, traffic incidents or other unanticipated events.

Weeklong Activities

Mile Marker	City/Town	Dates	Closure Details
0 – 44	Kittery – Scarborough	09/19 – 09/22	North and southbound lane closures from 6 am to 4:30 pm for guard rail repairs.
7 – 10	York	09/19 and 9/23	Northbound lane closure from 7 am to 3 pm for road maintenance operations.
35 – 37	Saco	9/19 – 9/20	North and southbound lane closure from 5 am to 5 pm for snow fence installation on the Exit 36 Overpass.
41 – 44	Scarborough	9/21 – 9/22	North and southbound lane closure from 5 am to 5 pm for snow fence Installation on the Exit 42 overpass and Gorham Road overpass.
45	South Portland	09/18 – 09/22	<p><i>Due to emergency bridge repairs, the Exit 45 southbound departing and entering ramps will be closed nightly between the hours of 9:30 pm and 6 am.</i></p> <p><i>Intermittent trooper-assisted traffic stops of up to 20 minutes in duration are also scheduled for southbound traffic at mile 45 between the hours of 9:30 pm and 6 am.</i></p>
51 - 53	Falmouth	09/19 – 09/20	Southbound lane closure is scheduled from 9 am to 6 am for bridge construction.
		09/21 – 09/23	Northbound lane closure is scheduled from 7 pm to 5 pm for bridge construction.
54 – 62	Falmouth – Gray	09/19 – 09/23	North and southbound lane closures from 6 am to 6 pm daily for pavement rehabilitation.
95	Litchfield	09/19 – 09/23	North and southbound lane closures are scheduled from 6 am to 6 pm for bridge construction.
106	Farmingdale	09/19 – 09/22	North and southbound lane closures from 6 am to 3 pm for bridge construction.

42	Scarborough	09/21/2016	Northbound lane closure from 9 am to 5 pm for emergency vehicle ramp construction.

Ongoing Activities, until further notice:

Mile Marker	City/Town	Closure Details
Exit 32	Biddeford	Vehicles and loads over 10' wide will not be permitted to ENTER the Maine Turnpike at the Biddeford Toll/Exit 32. (Vehicles exiting the Turnpike will not be impacted).
Exit 36	Saco	Vehicles and loads over 10' wide will not be permitted to EXIT the Maine Turnpike at the Saco Toll/Exit 36. (Vehicles entering the Turnpike will not be impacted).
Exit 45	South Portland	Vehicles and loads over 10' wide will not be permitted to ENTER for southbound travel OR EXIT the Maine Turnpike at the South Portland Toll/Exit 45 southbound. Vehicles traveling northbound will not be impacted. This is a modification to this restriction that begins on 9/12.
Exit 46 East	Portland	Vehicles and loads over 10' wide will not be permitted to ENTER the Maine Turnpike at the Jetport East/Exit 46 East Toll for northbound travel. Vehicles exiting the Turnpike on the northbound side will not be impacted.
Exit 53	Falmouth	Vehicles and loads over 10' wide will not be permitted to ENTER the Maine Turnpike at the West Falmouth Toll/Exit 53. (Vehicles exiting the Turnpike will not be impacted).
63 – 48	Gray – Portland	Vehicles and loads over 10' wide traveling Southbound on the Maine Turnpike must exit at or before Exit 63 (Gray) and may re-enter for southbound travel at Exit 48 (Portland). This restriction will remain in place until further notice. Northbound vehicles will not be restricted at this time.
79 – 81	Lewiston	North and southbound traffic is reduced to a single lane due to interchange construction at Exit 80.
80	Lewiston	Vehicles and loads over 13' wide traveling Northbound on the Maine Turnpike must exit at Exit 80 in Lewiston and may re-enter for northbound travel on the Exit 80 Northbound entering ramp.
99 – 100	West Gardiner	Due to construction at the West Gardiner Barrier Toll located at mile 100, a north and southbound lane closure will be in place until further notice.
100 Toll	West Gardiner	Due to construction at the West Gardiner Barrier Toll located at mile 100, lanes 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be closed until further notice.
