

SUMMER BIKE NIGHT RULES

1. No purchase necessary.
2. Must be 18 years or older to qualify and win.
3. The grand prize is a 2010 Harley Davidson FXD Super Glide (retail value \$12,000)
4. Register at official Summer Bike Night KLAQ remotes. Listen to 95.5 FM, KLAQ; on-line at klaq.com; and check the calendar at klaq.com for Summer Bike Nights event times, dates, and locations.
5. The promotional window is from June 30, 2011 to September 4, 2011.
6. The Harley Davidson FXD Super Glide will be awarded at the Grand Prize Event, September 4, 2011 at Western Playland.
