



# **OFFICIAL RULES**

ESPN, Townsquare Media, its subsidiaries and affiliated companies (together, the "Company"), will conduct the Contest substantially as described in these rules, and by participating, each participant agrees as follows:

## **Description of the Contest.**

### **Dates of Contest:**

Will begin on/about Tuesday October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Once we receive the first winning guess the contest will begin again for the next possible winner. Once we receive the second winning guess the contest will be over.

**NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. PURCHASE DOES NOT INCREASE ODDS OF WINNING. Void where prohibited. All decisions of the judges will be final.**

### **How to Enter:**

To enter, listeners will call in between 1 and 7 pm when they hear the cue to call. They must correctly guess exactly what the prize is in order to win.

The winner will get a "Double Play" Sports Experience. Contestants must correctly guess exactly what the Experience is during the phone call; partially correct guesses may be acknowledged but will not count as winning. The contestant must specifically name and/or describe:

- What they will be doing
- Where it will be, specifically down to where they will be standing.
- When it will occur, the specific date and time of when the experience will start

--What extras we will give them. We will state how many extra perks each of the 2 Double Play experiences will have

Only 1 guess will be allowed per call. No purchase necessary to participate or win. Purchase does not increase chance of winning. Void where prohibited. Odds of winning depend upon the number of participants.

- Contestants must be 18 years of age or older on October 9<sup>th</sup> 2012 to participate in the ESPN Radio 104.5 The Team Double Play. If contestants do not meet these qualifications, those contestants will be disqualified.

### **Grand Prize Winner:**

**Prize(s).** The prize(s) that may be awarded to the eligible winner(s) are:

**Eligibility and Limitations.** Participants and winner(s) must be U.S. residents at least 18-years old as determined by the Company. Only one (1) entry per person. Only one (1) prize per household for the Contest. Only one (1) prize per household from any of the Company's stations within any thirty (30) day period. Employees of the Company, the Contest's participating sponsors and their advertising agencies, employees of other radio or television stations, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.

**Delivery Disclaimer.** The Company disclaims all liability for any delays, mis-delivery, loss, or failure in the delivery of any item sent by mail, courier, express, electronic transmission, or other delivery method. The Company is not responsible for mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software

errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, including: failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmission of online entries, traffic congestion on telephone lines, the Internet or at any website or lost or unavailable network connections which may limit an online entrant's ability to participate in the Contest, and any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in the Contest. Entry forms in a register-to-win contest must be handwritten. No photocopies or mechanical reproductions of entry forms is permitted.

**Publicity; Use of Personal Information.** By participating, where allowed by law, all participants and winner(s) grant the Company exclusive permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices, and likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other contests and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use. By participating in the Contest, where allowed by law, participants agree that the Company may disclose personal information obtained from participants in the Contest to third parties and use such information for marketing and other purposes.

**Release.** By participating in the Contest, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against ESPN, the Company, its employees and agents, the Contest's sponsors and their respective employees and agents, for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the Contest, or from the use of any prize. In order to receive a prize, participants must sign an official waiver form provided by the Company.

**Taxes.** Any valuation of the prize(s) stated above is based on available information provided to the Company, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. If the conduct or outcome of the Contest is affected by human error, any mechanical malfunctions or failures of any kind, intentional interference or any event beyond the control of the Company, the Company reserves the right to terminate this Contest, or make such other

decisions regarding the outcome as the Company deems appropriate. All decisions will be made by the Company and are final. The Company may waive any of these rules in its sole discretion.

**Miscellaneous.** Each winner must submit proof of eligibility and sign the Company's release form to claim the prize. The Company may substitute prizes, amend the rules or discontinue the Contest at any time as announced on the Station(s). The Company disclaims any responsibility to notify participants of any aspect related to the conduct of the Contest. For a copy of the rules, or where required by law, a list of winners, visit the business office of the Station during normal business hours or mail a written request with a stamped, self-addressed return envelope to the Station's address, listed above. All entries become the property of the Company and will not be returned.

**Compliance with Law.** The conduct of the Contest is governed by the applicable laws of the United States of America, which take precedence over any rule to the contrary herein. Station(s) shall follow the applicable laws for conducting contests, including notice to the state attorney general or consumer affairs office, posting of a prize bond, furnishing lists of winners, running specific on-air disclaimers, providing specific written information about the Contest, etc. as required by local and state law.
