

Bracket Play Rules

How it Works:

- The higher ranked team gets to pick which side of the court they want to play on.
- Teams will get 5 minutes between games to warm up. No warming up during other games.
- 1 timeout per team is allowed per game.
- Losing team may be required to ref the following Bracket Play match.
- Bracket Play matches are one game to 25 points. Winning team must have a 2-point lead.
- Championship match is two games to 21 with a 15 point tie-breaking game.

Reffing Duties:

Referee Team is in charge of making FINAL calls.

- Calling ball “in” and “out” (if ball TOUCHES THE LINE, it is IN)
- Calling “double contact” or “lift”
- Calling “net” when players come in contact with the volleyball net
- Reporting inappropriate and unsportsmanlike conduct
- Keeping score
- Circling winning team and writing down score after game

*We will review these rules and calls at the Captain’s meeting.

Penalties:

- If a team is late to play, the opposing team automatically receives a 5-point advance.
- If Playing OR Refing Team has unsportsmanlike conduct, they will be warned once, then disqualified.
