Keithi M. Worthington, Chief Prosecuting Attorney for the City of Missoula, Montana, being first duly sworn, states as follows:

On June 5, 2020 Mark Belden committed the offenses of Unlawful Restraint in violation of Section 45-5-301, MCA and Operating as a Private Security Guard without a License, in violation of Section 37-60-301, MCA.

These charges are based upon the following facts which have been obtained from reports of law enforcement officers which, if true, I believe constitute sufficient probable cause for the above listed offenses. These facts are as follows:

On or about the 5th day of June, multiple Missoula police officers received complaints from persons at the Black Lives Matter rally at the Missoula Courthouse of a suspicious person, whose identity was concealed, that was making people nervous. Officers observed the individual, who was wearing a hooded sweatshirt with the hood tied tight around the face, a black face covering, and sun glasses, riding around the area on a bike. Due to how this person was dressed, Officers could not identify this person's gender or race.

At approximately 2100 hours, officers heard a disturbance on the Courthouse lawn and observed a group of people detaining an individual (victim), who was the person identified as suspicious by multiple complainants earlier in the day. The victim reported an armed individual, later identified as the Defendant Mark Belden, stopped him in an alleyway and demanded multiple times that the victim show his face or identify himself to Defendant. The victim did not know Defendant and the Defendant had no authority to stop the victim and demand the victim identify himself. The victim

stated he was scared and attempted to run away from the Defendant, at which time he heard someone yell to get him. Defendant later admitted to yelling "get him" when the victim turned and ran.

An uninvolved bystander, who reported hearing someone shout "get him" and "gun" and saw the victim running towards the protestors, thought the victim might have a weapon, tripped the victim and held him until law enforcement could arrive.

Officers spoke to one of the event organizers, Kanyon Stevens, who confirmed that Defendant had stopped and confronted the victim in an alley just east of the Courthouse.

Multiple Missoula Police Officers were familiar with Defendant, as he was an armed male who had shown up at the protest daily and assumed a role as security. Defendant told police that he had been acting as personal security for some of the Black Lives Matter event organizers. This was confirmed by Kanyon Stevens and another event organizer. Defendant has no license or training to act as a private security guard.
