On Aug. 4 at approximately 2 p.m., Missoula police officers responded to Splash Montana at 3001 Bancroft for a reported male-versus-male disturbance.

On arrival, officers were informed that one of the two males had been discovered videotaping adult women in the family dressing/changing stalls. The suspect had been occupying the handicapped stall and had been videotaping from over the top of the divider between the stalls when he was discovered. The reporting victim's husband detained the suspect at the scene after he initially attempted to flee.

Officers identified the suspect male as a 37-year-old Missoula resident. Several items of evidence were seized, and Missoula Police Department detectives interviewed several witnesses and the suspect.

Following a compilation of all of the statements, facts and evidence, the Missoula Police Department has referred the case to the Missoula County Attorney's Office with the recommendation that the suspect be charged with Felony Burglary and Felony Tampering with Evidence.
