Public Sight-in at the Deer Creek Shooting Center

MISSOULA - The Western Montana Fish and Game Association announces that it will conduct a public sight-in day at its Deer Creek Shooting Center (DCSC) between East Missoula and Bonner on Sunday, October 7th. This opportunity will begin at 10 AM and will last until 4 PM.

The DCSC is one of the most well developed shooting facilities in the Northwest, and is located along Deer Creek Road just south of the Montana Rail Link tracks.

This public sight-in day is intended for hunters to get tuned up and checked out prior to the opening of general big game season.

Interested persons must bring their own rifle and ammunition. Eye and ear protection will be required for all participants. Participants will be required to sign a liability waiver before using the DCSC on this public sight-in day. Participants should bring the paper targets they prefer to use, and tape or a staple gun to affix targets to available wooden target backers. The distances available for sight-in will be 25 yards and 100 yards.

WMFGA President Jim McDonald commented, "We're pleased to be able to offer this opportunity to the Missoula-area public."

Access to the DCSC is usually only available to the WMFGA's 2,500 local members, who have access all days of the year, all daylight hours. Persons interested in becoming a WMFGA member may join at the gun counter of Bob Ward's or Wholesale Sports.
