Key Reserve Street Intersections Set for Repair Work Wednesday Evening through Thursday Morning

The intersections of Reserve Street and South Avenue and Reserve Street and Brooks Street will likely see traffic delays until about 9 a.m. Thursday because of manhole repair work.

The work will begin at 9 p.m. Wednesday – tonight – and traffic controls will be in place to allow the concrete used in the repairs to set and cure. Drivers should allow extra time during the morning rush and should avoid the area if possible.

The repairs are routine work that's necessary because of the wear and tear of passing traffic over the manholes. They are a joint project of the City of Missoula and the Montana Department of Transportation, as Reserve Street is a state route.

Crews will make every effort to cause minimal disruption.
