The facts constituting the offense are:



SUZY BOYLAN, Deputy County Attorney of Missoula County,
Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the
investigation of RYAN MITCHELL RUDH for allegedly committing the
offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information
contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify
charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying
complaint.

On or about the 29th day of December, 2012, officers responded to
Palmer Drug for a report of a robbery. Store employees Laura Vigil and
Kelly Shields reported that a male wearing a mask came to the pharmacy

1 and had a note indicating he had a gun, demanding drugs, and advising
2 them not to call law enforcement. He was given approximately 685 tablets
3 of Oxycodone in 5 mg doses. He also asked for Fentanyl patches. One of
4 the victims recalled a suspicious male in the pharmacy the previous day,
5 asking if they carried Oxycodone and Fentanyl. That male appeared to be
6 under the influence of an intoxicating substance. Video of that male was
7 obtained and a still photograph of that male made from the video was
8 released to the media.



12 Detective Katie Petersen received a call identifying the above-named
13 Defendant as the suspect. They went to Defendant's home. His mother
14 started crying immediately and stated she knew why they were there.
15 Defendant was at home. He was cooperative but initially denied committing
16 the robbery. Both Defendant's mother and sister identified him as the
17 suspect from the photographs provided by the pharmacy.

21 Defendant eventually admitted that he committed the robbery. He
22 said he wrote the note at home and went to Palmer's Drug. He picked
23 Palmer's because there was a snow bank by the store that he could park
24 behind. He obtained about five bottles of 5mg Oxycodone pills. He told
25 detectives where to find the pills at home. A bottle of pills was retrieved
26 from Defendant's residence.


