Jordan Kilby, Deputy County Attorney of Missoula County, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of ROBERT WILLIAM CURRAN for allegedly committing the offenses set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 4th day of July, 2013, Robert Curran and his fiancé Ashley Rognstad began to argue at their residence at 4000 Mullan Road, Missoula County. Ashley contacted Robert's mother, Donna, and drove to Donna's residence at 318 S Grove, Missoula County, to spend the night there. Robert followed Ashley in his car.

When Ashley arrived at Donna's home, she went inside. Robert followed her.

Robert went into a room in which he used to stay and grabbed a .45 caliber handgun AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

and left the residence. Robert drove home to 4000 Mullan Road where he loaded six rounds into the gun. He then returned to 318 S Grove St.

He got out of his truck with the gun in his right hand. He walked back into his mother's residence and chambered a round. He then began yelling at his mother and Ashley. Robert admitted to waiving the gun around and towards them. Donna stated at one point, Ashley got behind Donna, hoping Robert would not shoot his mother. Ashley stated she didn't know if Robert wanted to hurt her or someone.

Robert's brother Richard came upstairs. Robert admitted to pointing the gun at his brother as his brother was trying to "talk him down." Robert heard police sirens and took the magazine out of the handgun and threw it across the room. He retrieved it and walked out of the residence. He was arrested without incident.
