10 JASON MARKS, Assistant Chief Deputy County Attorney, deposes
11 and says that on or about the 27th day of November, 2013, in Missoula
12 County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: ATTEMPTED
13 DELIBERATE HOMICIDE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely:
14 Mont. Code Ann. §§ 45-5-102[1] and 45-4-103, punishable by death, life
15 imprisonment, or not less than 10 or more than 100 years MSP; COUNT II:
16 ROBBERY, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann.
17 § 45-5-401, punishable by not less than 2 or more than 40 years MSP and/or
18 \$50,000 fine.

23 The facts constituting the offense are:

24 COUNT I: On or about the 27th day of November, 2013, with the
25 purpose to commit deliberate homicide, Defendant shot a Missoula City
26 HIDTA detective.

14 JASON MARKS, Assistant Chief Deputy County Attorney, Montana,

16 being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

17 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the
18 investigation of JOSHUA L. ROBINSON for allegedly committing the
19 offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information
20 contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify
21 charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying
22 complaint.

25 On or about the 27th day of November, 2013, a Missoula City High
26 Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) detective was sitting in his vehicle
27 in the Rosauer's parking lot, in Missoula County, waiting to do a controlled
28

1 buy of methamphetamine. The detective had previously arranged with
2 Jazmine Beehler purchase drugs at that location.
3

4 The detective, while sitting in his vehicle, was approached on the
5 passenger side by two males. One of the males was Joshua Robinson.
6
7 The detective inquired where Beehler was and Robinson stated she was
8 going to meet him there.
9

10 The detective stated that he only wished to deal with one of the
11 individuals and the other male walked away. Robinson told the detective to
12 turn his vehicle off and Robinson got in the detective's vehicle. Robinson
13 asked to see the cash before he provided the product. The detective
14 showed him the money. Robinson pulled out a flashlight and acted as if he
15 were going to get out the drugs.


18 Robinson then turned to the detective and produced a pistol from his
19 right front pocket. Robinson told the detective to give him the money.
20
21 Robinson pointed the gun directly at the detective and told him to put his
22 hands up. The detective produced a gun and Robinson shot the detective
23 in an exchange of gunfire.

25 Subsequent investigation revealed that Robinson fired two shots from
26 his handgun and a third round jammed in the gun.


