COMPLAINT


JASON MARKS, Assistant Chief Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 18th day of December, 2013, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offense of COUNT I: CONSPIRACY to commit SEXUAL ABUSE OF CHILDREN, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-4-102 and 45-5-625, punishable by Life or 100 years MSP and a \$10,000 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 18th day of December, 2013, the above-named Defendant, with the purpose that the offense of Sexual Abuse of Children be committed, agreed with Chad Briggs to the commission of the offense and an act in furtherance of the agreement was committed in that the Defendant and Chad Briggs traveled to a house in Missoula for a sexual encounter with what they believed was a 12 year old child.

14 JASON MARKS, Assistant Chief Deputy County Attorney, Montana,  
15 being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

17 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the  
18 investigation of JENNA ELIZABETH DAVIS for allegedly committing the  
19 offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information  
20 contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify  
21 charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying  
22 complaint.

25 On or about the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2013, the Montana Internet  
26 Crimes Against Children task force along with members of the Missoula  
27 Police Department, Missoula County Sheriff's Department, and Flathead


1 County Sheriff's Department began a sting operation targeting people  
2 seeking to have sex with underage girls. They posted ads on Craigslist  
3 and Backpage purporting to be posted by a woman willing to make a 12  
4 year old female relative available for sexual encounters. Officers then  
5 posed as the woman and her 12 year old relative in text message  
6 exchanges and phone conversations with people responding to the ads.  
7

9  
10 On December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013, Jenna Davis responded to one of the  
11 Craigslist ads. She indicated that her boyfriend, Chad Brigg, would be  
12 interested in helping the 12 year old girl, who was the apparent subject of  
13 the ad, lose her virginity. She said that Briggs had been involved in a prior  
14 sexual encounter with an underage girl and it had been a positive  
15 experience. She indicated that she was calling to make sure that the  
16 Craigslist posting was legitimate.

20 Subsequently Chad Briggs called the undercover detective. He  
21 assured the detective that he would bring condoms and be gentle with the  
22 12 year old. He was given the address of the house being used for the  
23 operation.

26 Shortly after 9 p.m. Davis contacted the undercover detective and  
27 indicated that she and Briggs were on their way. She indicated that Briggs  
28 was concerned that nerves might interfere with his ability to get an erection

1 and asked if it would be okay if she was in the room during the encounter to  
2 help Briggs get ready. Both Davis and Briggs arrived at the house in  
3 Missoula and were taken into custody.
