JENNIFER CLARK, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 27th day of April, 2015, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of

12 JENNIFER CLARK, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon  
13 oath, deposes and says:

14 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of  
15 ALLAN ROBERT BUSCAGLIA for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the  
16 complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe  
17 probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the  
18 accompanying complaint.

20 On April 27, 2015, officers were dispatched to Taco Bell at 2320 N. Reserve after  
21 a teenager called to report a male had offered him and his friend money for sex acts.  
22 The teenager provided a description of the male and his vehicle. Officer Smith located  
23 the vehicle and stopped the driver. He was identified as Allan Buscaglia. Officer Smith  
24 informed him that he had stopped him regarding an incident at Taco Bell. Buscaglia  
25 stated that they were staring at him. Officer Smith asked what happened next and he  
26 motioned to a wad of cash in his shirt pocket and said, "Well, I offered them some cash  
27 for sex."
