AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

JASON MARKS, Assistant Chief Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of NEAL LEWIS GRAY for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint in and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the abovenamed defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On or about the 17th day of December, 2013, the Montana Internet Crimes Against Children task force along with members of the Missoula Police Department, Missoula County Sheriff's Department, and Flathead County Sheriff's Department began a sting operation targeting people

seeking to have sex with underage girls. They posted ads on Craigslist and Backpage purporting to be posted by a woman willing to make a 12 year old female relative available for sexual encounters. Officers then posed as the woman and her 12 year old relative in text message exchanges and phone conversations with people responding to the ads.

On December 18th, 2013, Neal Gray responded to the ad and indicated a desire to engage in sexual intercourse with the 12 year old and discussed specific sex acts that he wished to perform on her. He was then given and the address of a house in Missoula being used for the operation. Shortly after 11:00 pm on December 18, 2013, Gray arrived that the address given by the undercover officers. He was taken into custody. In his possession were rope, handcuffs, lube, nipple clamps, a whip, clothes pins, and latex gloves.

Gray was interviewed and confessed that he had driven to the house believing that he was going to be having sex with a 12 year old girl.
