**COMPLAINT**

SUZY BOYLAN, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 21st day of September, 2016, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: ASSAULT - PHYSICAL CONTACT OF INSULTING NATURE, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-201, punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$500 fine; COUNT II: SEXUAL ASSAULT, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-502(1)[1st], punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$500 fine; COUNT III: SEXUAL ASSAULT, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-502(1)[2nd], punishable by 12 months MCDF and/or \$1000 fine; COUNT IV: SEXUAL ASSAULT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-502(1)[3rd], punishable by up to 5 years in the Montana State Prison and a fine of \$10,000. If Defendant is found to be a Persistent

1 Felony Offender, the penalty for a third offense may be not less than 5 years or more than  
2 100 years in the Montana State Prison.

3 The facts constituting the offense are:

5 COUNT I: On or about the 21st day of September, 2016, the above-named  
6 Defendant purposely or knowingly made physical contact of an insulting or provoking  
7 nature with Jane Doe 1, age 14, by telling her she was "hot" and touching her hair.

8  
9 COUNT II: On or about the 21st day of September, 2016, the above-named  
10 Defendant knowingly subjected Jane Doe 2 to sexual contact by grabbing her hand and  
11 trying to put it down his pants, without consent.

12  
13 COUNT III: On or about the 21st day of September, 2016, the above-named  
14 Defendant knowingly subjected Jane Doe 3 to sexual contact, by running his hand down  
15 her back and buttocks and/or smacking he on the buttocks, without consent, a second  
16 offense.

17  
18 COUNT IV: On or about the 21st day of September, 2017, the above-named  
19 Defendant knowingly subjected Jane Doe 4 to sexual contact by grabbing her buttocks,  
20 a third or subsequent offense.

26 SUZY BOYLAN, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon  
27 oath, deposes and says:

28 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of  
TIMOTHY GENE QUIGG for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint  
and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause  
exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying  
complaint.

On or about the 21<sup>st</sup> day of September, 2016, officers responded to the Mountain  
Line Bus Depot for a report of a disorderly male who was groping people. A group of

1 teenage girls reported that Defendant touched them. Jane Doe 1 reported that the male  
2 kept telling her how "hot" she was, touched her hair, and told her she should grow her  
3 hair out. Jane Doe 2 reported that the male asked to see her hand, then grabbed it and  
4 tried to put it down his pants. He made a comment to her about how she "couldn't  
5 handle" what he could give to her. Jane Doe 3 reported that the male made crude  
6 comments to her and referenced how she looked, then ran his hand down her back and  
7 buttocks and then smacked her on the buttocks. Jane Doe 4 reported the male fully  
8 grabbed her buttocks with both hands.

11 The victims and multiple witnesses described the suspect male. He was  
12 described as appearing to be in his late 40s or early 50s, wearing a rust or orange hat  
13 that said "2016 Sturgis" and having a tattoo or large freckle in the corner of his right eye.  
14 He was believed to be intoxicated. He was tentatively identified from a Mountain Line  
15 surveillance video as the above-named Defendant. On September 22, MPD received a  
16 report that the suspect was at Mountain Line again. He was wearing an orange/brown  
17 hat that said "Sturgis 2016" and has a tattoo at the corner of his right eye. Defendant  
18 was arrested. In an interview he told Detective Franke he was blackout drunk and didn't  
19 remember anything before he invoked his right to remain silent.
