**COMPLAINT** 

BRIAN LOWNEY, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 4th day of March, 2017, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offenses of COUNT I: ASSAULT WITH WEAPON, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-213, punishable by 20 years MSP and/or \$50,000 fine; COUNT II: PARTNER OR FAMILY MEMBER ASSAULT - 2ND OFFENSE, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-206[2nd], punishable by not less than 72 hours or more than one year MCDF and a fine not less than \$300 or more than \$1000.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 4th day of March, 2017, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to Jane Doe with a weapon, to wit: a propane tank.

COUNT II: On or about the 4th day of March, 2017, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to Jane Doe, a partner.

BRIAN LOWNEY, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

Plaintiff.

Defendant,

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of DERAN M TAYLOR for allegedly committing the offense(s) set forth in the complaint and based upon the information contained in the reports, if true, believe probable cause exists to justify charging the above-named defendant as specified in the accompanying complaint.

On March 25, 2017, Missoula County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a report of an assault from a victim who was presenting at the Missoula Police

Department. Deputies responded and met Jane Doe, who reported that the Defendant, her husband, had assaulted her several times over the past three (3) weeks. Deputies observed a very large bruise on Doe's left eye.

Doe detailed several recent assaults by the Defendant, the first of which occurred three (3) weeks prior at their home in Missoula County, MT. Doe indicated that the Defendant became upset with her during an argument and that he grabbed a small propane tank that was inside the house. Doe indicated that the Defendant then swung the propane bottle at her, hesitated about halfway through his swing, and then continued the swing with the propane bottle until it struck her in the left ankle. Doe indicated she felt "instantaneous pain" and that her "ankle hurt so bad that [she] couldn't put weight on it." Doe went to the hospital, where she was told she had a "cracked bone."

Doe detailed that the Defendant caused her black eye by hitting her with either his elbow or his fist during an argument sometime after he had hit her with the propane tank. Doe indicated that on March 23, 2017, the Defendant had kicked a fan into her leg, causing cuts and a bruise. Doe indicated that the day prior, March 24, 2017, the Defendant became upset with her and shoved her head into a wall, causing her pain.

Deputies spoke with Doe's 6 year old child, who indicated that the Defendant had caused Doe's black eye and that the Defendant had kicked the fan into Doe's shin, causing Doe to need "a Band-Aid but they were all out of Band-Aids."

Deputies spoke with the Defendant, who denied causing any injury to Doe. The Defendant has a Domestic Battery charge against Doe currently pending in Henderson, Nevada, based on an incident date in the Fall of 2016.
